Northern California Little League Tournament Dress Code Following is the dress code in effect for all Northern California District and Section tournaments.

- 1. Little League/Minors Docker type pants, slacks or hemmed shorts are required for managers and coaches; no denim type pants or shorts, camo pants or basketball style shorts, cut off or ragged shorts will be allowed. Gusseted pockets on cargo-type shorts should lay flat. Shorts MUST be no higher than 2 inches above the knees and no lower than the knees. The pants, slacks, or shorts must be the same color for both the manager and coaches. Collared shirts or team jersey/tee shirts are required and should be tucked in the shorts/pants. No tank tops are allowed.
- 2. Junior League Managers and coaches may wear full uniforms. If not in full uniforms, they must look alike in all shorts or all pants.
- 3. No open toe shoes or sandals will be allowed.
- 4. Team hats or visors will be required for the manager and coaches.

Any manager or coach who does not conform to the dress code will not be allowed on the playing field before or during the game. The purpose of the dress code is to ensure an acceptable uniform appearance of all participants and to promote a positive role model for the players and spectators at the tournament sites. The host District Administrator, or his/her designee (e.g., ADA or Tournament Director) at the tournament site, will use their discretion in determining what is appropriate within the guidelines of the dress code and their determination is final for their tournament site.
